

### Fill out the attached registration form & return it to your local branch library any time in June or July to register.

Visit your local branch library any time in June or July to register or **sign up online at blrLibrary.org** 

**Tots, children, and teens** get a copy of the Reading Log. Use the "Reading Log" to set a goal and track what you read or listen to over the summer.

**New this year!** Classrooms and Daycares can also participate. They will receive a set of bookmarks, activity sheets, and a reading log when they register their classroom or daycare.

All reading or listening material counts: books, magazines, newspapers, manga, graphic novels, audio books, etc. You can read or someone may read to you.

Join us for free programs throughout the summer. Check with your local branch library for dates and times.

**Prizes** (read at least one book in June and one in July):

**Tots (0-3)** will receive a bottle of bubbles chart in June and a pair of glasses in July.

**Children (3-12)** will receive a color magnet in June and a jar of slime in July.

**Teens (13-18)** will receive a lanyard in June and a galaxy kickball in July.

**Adults (18 and older)** will receive a book bag at the end of the summer. Adults may also complete entry forms for prize drawings in June (gripper bottle) and July (puzzle). One winner per location.
